Kenny Moorer - The Handwriting On The Wall

Brother Moorer discussed Daniel Chapter 5 and focused on the importance of accountability to God and explained that judgment can occur suddenly, without warning, just like what happened to King Belshazzar. He urged us to find the right purpose in life and to prioritize what God wants.

- [] Discuss with family and friends how Belshazzar's story demonstrates the importance of humility, faithfulness, and prompt obedience to God's will.

- King slain, kingdom taken down in minutes. Immediate judgement.

The importance of accountability and judgment based on the story of Belshazzar.

- The importance of accountability to God.
- Judgment can occur suddenly, without warning. Urgency of living a life pleasing to God.
- Belshazzar's disregard for God's warnings and how we can learn from it.

Finding purpose and the right priorities

- Be ready for judgement, have the right purpose and the right priorities
- Psalm 39, the fleeting nature of human life.
- Prioritize what God wants

Prioritizing God in life, avoiding selfish desires.

- Don't play games with God always put Him first.
- Personal accountability in response to Belshazzar's story.
